## OUR YEAR IN REVIEW...

### MAY, 2020 - INCORPORATION

In May of 2020, three friends and veterinary professionals got together and came up with an idea. Almost daily we saw families whose pets needed life-saving care but could not afford it. Many of those pets were otherwise healthy and would lead a quality life with treatment, but many of those families had to choose between paying their electric bill, rent, car insurance, etc., or paying for their pet's treatment.. Leading to the tough choice of euthanizing their pet so that they did not suffer any longer.

So Another Day Fund was formed with the mission statement “to keep families together with their pets by providing access to necessary medical care when quality of life can be preserved.”

## JULY 2020 - LAUNCH PARTY & OUR FIRST LIFE SAVED

Our launch party and silent auction got us off on a great foot, raising over \$1300 to help families in need.

Shortly after our launch party, Flaca’s owner came to us after trying her hardest to raise all the money needed to have Flaca’s eye removed. Flaca was in pain but would lead a healthy life without the eye. Thanks to our generous donors, we were able to get Flaca the help she needed. Flaca was our first Another Day Pet, and her case made us hungry to help more families.

## SEPTEMBER 2020 - CANELA AND BELLA’S SURGERIES

Both Canela and Bella’s owners had heard about us by word of mouth and reached out because they needed help saving their pets. Luckily we were able to help both because of the help of our very responsive donors. In September, Canela had her infected uterus removed - something that can be deadly if left untreated - and Bella had her leg amputated, preserving her quality of life and giving her a long, healthy life with her family.

## OCTOBER 2020 - BIRTHDAY FUNDRAISERS RAISE OVER \$1000

In October, three of our supporters held Facebook birthday fundraisers to benefit Another Day Fund, raising over \$1000 to help families and their pets.

## NOVEMBER 2020 - NOT SLOWING DOWN

In November, we were able to hold a fundraiser at Lazy Dog and spread more awareness of what we do at Another Day Fund.

## DECEMBER 2020 - WRAPPING UP THE YEAR

December marked the end of our first fiscal year. In the five short months that we operated in 2020, we raised almost \$4,000 to save three lives and continue to work hard to find more avenues for development and reach more people so that those in need can find us when they need our help.


# 2020 IMPACT REVIEW

## 2021 GOALS

Being a startup organization amid an international pandemic and state of crisis has not been easy. But BECAUSE so many families are suffering financially, we cannot stop working. Families need programs like the one offered by Another Day Fund so that they can stay together. Our goal is to continue to reach at least 1 family per month for the remainder of our first year.

We aim to broaden our influence and reach families not only in the Las Vegas Valley, but the entirety of the high desert. In order to do so, we need to continue our fundraising efforts. We have plans for a few events in 2021 so far and aim to have 1 small event monthly with larger events quarterly.

With the help of our fabulous support system, we aim to have raised \$15,000 by August 2021 and to have saved 12 pets' lives.
